

Demographics of 2009 Survey

- Respondents were evenly distributed between live and on-line
- Predominantly female ages 41 years or older
- Reside in northeast (40.3%) or south central (23.6%)
- Employed by local, state or federal government (74.5%)
- Predominantly administrative or supervisory (46.8%), health education (16.0%), academic (13.5%)
- Employed in job less than 10 years (53.2%)
- Plan to retire in greater than 10 years (62.3%)
- Wichita (29.9%), Kansas City (28.6%), Topeka (20.4%) are preferred locations for meetings/conferences

KPHA Services

- Have used the KPHA Statutes and Regulations Book (29.4%)
- Nearly 60% would like on-line training on using the Statutes and Regs book
- 48% would be likely or very likely to participate in a section-specific webinar
- Approximately 50% prefer live webinar and 50% passive webinar
- Only 5% have used the KPHA Orientation Manual through TRAIN
- Orientation to Public Health used in new hire orientation by 11.6% of respondents
- Frequency of updating the Orientation Manual, every 2-3 years (57.7%) and yearly (26.1%)
